

Subject: Waju aidpost medical supply report

This is a report for the aid post in the Waju village that was built by the ROTARY INTERNATIONAL of AUSTRALIA in 1994. Since 2005 to date, there is always been a problem of medical supply not getting to the aid post.

We were assured by the government through the Department of Health that our medical supply of two kit boxes would be sent on quarterly bases but failed to reach us. We have been in search for medical supply to KOKODA and the GENERAL HOSPITAL in Popondetta from time to time throughout the years and would receive very little supply, which would last only a week or would receive nothing as always been the case.

As for the year 2008, there is hardly any medicine, which has resulted in a number of deaths that was caused by malaria and TB cases.

I would greatly appreciate you helping us with a couple of poly water tanks for the aid post and the people of the community of Waju.
